

Adjusting the Pressure Switch

1. Ensure spa is filled to the correct level and filters are clean. Locate the grey control box, and check the power is switched on.
2. You will find the pressure switch in a grey plastic housing. This is located in the bottom left corner of the control box, and is on the reverse side of the heater. The housing has top and bottom access points, and holds a black, spiky wheel.
3. Put your thumb in the top access point, and your index finger in the bottom access point (see picture below)
4. Then rotate the cog clockwise until it stops then rotate anti-clockwise until you hear a click. This is a relay switching, and is a light, tinny sound.
5. The spa should now function correctly. If the problem persists repeat steps 3 and 4 rotating the cog in the other direction.
